Now launching into its fourth year in 2021, Leadership Orleans is a new and exciting year-long educational program focused on building leadership skills while exposing participants to awareness, experiences, knowledge and individuals who work for the betterment of the community. Leadership Orleans is following in the footsteps of hundreds of community leadership programs across the region, state and country.

Community leadership programs have been helping to create leadership skills that spring communities into positive action for more than forty years. Orleans County has joined this national movement, and we invite you to be part of the journey.

Sessions include retreats, stimulating activities, interaction with community experts and tours. All day sessions are presented in an *adult experiential learning* environment around topics such as ethical leadership capacity building, servant leadership, economic and workforce development, agribusiness, community health, culture and arts, diversity, education, tourism and recreation, and the public sector.

## **Program Highlights:**

- > Participants meet for thirteen full days throughout the year, generally one per month.
- The program helps individuals assess their leadership style and ways to relate to other styles.
- > Each class will have approximately twenty-five individuals from all walks of life.
- Admission is based on review of the application and personal contact made by staff/volunteers.
- An applicant should have the full support of the sponsoring business/organization, unless the applicant is applying personally.
- > Applications are due by November 1st.
- > Tuition is \$1,950.00.
